Investigative Assistance

- RISSIntel Criminal Intelligence
 Database allows law enforcement
 members to query up to 32 databases
 connected in a nationwide network to
 all six RISS Centers and receive online
 results in real time. RISSIntel contains
 millions of records, including
 individuals, organizations, groups, and
 associates suspected of involvement in
 criminal activity, as well as locations,
 vehicles, weapons, and phone
 numbers.
- ROCIC fulfills requests from members looking for criminals, fugitives, wanted persons, relatives, associates, victims, witnesses, and missing persons. A comprehensive intelligence report is compiled and returned in a matter of hours after consulting a number of databases (subscription, public record, state-based, and law enforcement specific). Driver's license photos can be obtained quickly.
- ROCIC assists with officer inquiries: Social Security Number • Date of Birth • Locate Suspects • Address Verification • Other Household Members • Neighbors • Property Ownership & Deeds • Professional Licenses • Civil Judgments & Liens • Pilot & Aircraft Information • Vessel & Marine Radio Licenses • Assets • Business Addresses & Phone Numbers • Reverse Phone Number Lookup • Phone Carrier Information • Subpoena Information for Unpublished Phone Numbers, Credit Bureaus, etc. • Driver's License Information • Federal Firearms Licenses • Employment Information • Contact Information for LEOs Nationwide • Criminal Histories.



RISSNET Resources Available 24/7

- **RISSLeads Investigative Website** provides authorized law enforcement officers with the ability to post information regarding cases, investigative leads, or other law enforcement issues. Authorized users are able to view and respond to posts.
- **RISSGang Website and Database** is a comprehensive gang resource that offers a criminal intelligence database and a website, which includes informational resources. The database provides agencies with access to gang information, including suspects, organizations, weapons, photographs, and graffiti. Available to all authorized law enforcement, RISSGang contains hundreds of thousands of database records and provides for a federated search, including CalGang.
- Secure Email provides electronic communications for members to exchange sensitive information. More than 30 million email transactions occur each year. If your agency doesn't have secure email, use ours.
- **RISS ATIX (Automated Trusted Information Exchange) Website** provides law enforcement, public safety, and critical infrastructure personnel with access to homeland security, disaster, and terrorist threat information.
- RISSNET provides secure access to critical national information resources: Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) Electronic Learning Portal, Fusion Center Assistance and Nationwide Suspicious Activity Reporting (SAR) Initiative (NSI), Secure Hosted Websites (SharePoint) For Agency Collaboration, GFIPM and LEO Enterprise Portal, INTERPOL, National Criminal Intelligence Resource Center (NCIRC), National Identity Crimes Law Enforcement (NICLE) Network, National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS), National Railroad Trespasser Database, National Virtual Pointer System (NVPS), National White Collar Crime Center (NW3C), U.S. Secret Service's Targeted Violence Information Sharing System (TAVISS).



Officer Safety

- **RISS Officer Safety Website** serves as a nationwide repository for issues related to officer safety, such as concealments, hidden weapons, armed and dangerous threats, officer safety videos, special reports, and training.
- **RISSafe Event Deconfliction** provides for the controlled and secure monitoring of surveillance, undercover, and investigative operations and the immediate notification of affected parties when conflicts arise. A RISSafe mobile app is also available.



Analysis

 ROCIC provides analytical services to member agencies for the analysis of investigative data and/or complex intelligence regarding criminals, organizations, groups, businesses, and criminal activity. The objective of this service is to convert raw, disorganized, unfinished information into "focused" or finished intelligence. Services include link analysis, phone records analysis and cell tower mapping, crime scene diagrams, complex and specialized flowcharts, bulk data analysis, and financial analysis reports.



Digital Forensics

- Digital forensics services are available to assist law enforcement member agencies to investigate and establish facts in criminal cases involving digital evidence. Services include acquisition, authentication, reconstruction, examination, and analysis of data stored on electronic media.
- Audio/video forensics can enhance recordings for better use in investigations and the courtroom.



Equipment Loans

- Specialized surveillance and investigative equipment is available for short-term loan to members at no charge (return shipping charges may apply).
- Equipment for loan includes video cameras, camcorders, optical devices, thermal imaging, bodywire gear, audio recorders, night vision, still cameras, RF vehicle tracking, GPS logging, outdoor equipment devices, digital time-lapse recorders, and much more.



Publications

- Investigative and case information submitted by officers is posted to ROCIC's secure Website as searchable eBulletin articles, organized by crime category and by state.
- All articles are published in the monthly online ROCIC Bulletin, which can be downloaded and printed. Bulletins are archived online for easy accessibility.
- Special Research Reports cover various topics of timely concern to law enforcement, including officer safety, gangs, narcotics, sovereign citizens, digital media, and criminal trends and investigative techniques. Reports are online and interactive, and include updated background documentation and digital media.
- Time-sensitive, localized information is emailed to member agencies.



Training

- ROCIC Membership Information Sharing and Training Conferences are conducted three times each year, throughout the ROCIC region, on topics such as homicide, narcotics, and gangs.
- Law enforcement training classes are held at the full-featured ROCIC Training Facility located at ROCIC headquarters in Nashville, Tenn. The facility is also available for use by member agencies at no charge.
- ROCIC sponsors specialized training on topics of local concern throughout its 14-state region.
